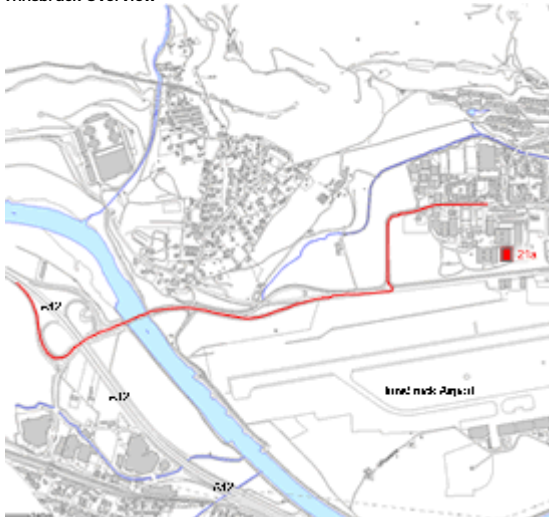

## By Car

### A12

- EXIT Kranebitten
- At the STOP sign you take a left and keep following this street
- At the roundabout take the second street
- Technikerstrasse
- After a very sharp right turn there is the University campus on the right hand side
- Park the car on the left side of the street (Attention: short term parking zone)

Other parking possibilities:

- Car Park of the ICT - Technologie Park

## By Plane

Airport Innsbruck is a small airport operated mainly by Air Alps and Austrian Arrows. There are direct flights to and from the following cities:

- Amsterdam,
- Frankfurt,
- Graz,
- Hannover,
- London (Gatwick),
- Vienna.

The nearest major airport is Airport Munich. Shuttle transfer is available, for more information please check out <http://www.airport-transfer.com/>

To get to ecca from the airport you can take a taxi. The taxi stops are located immediately in front of the arrival building. The journey takes about 10 minutes and costs around € 7.-. Please tell the taxi driver that you would like to go to the University of Innsbruck, Campus Technikerstraße.

## By Train

Innsbruck's main train station is located directly in the city center. A taxi ride to the campus takes about 20 minutes and costs about € 12.-. Please tell the taxi driver that you would like to go to the University of Innsbruck, Campus Technikerstraße.

If you want to use public transportation, take the E or D bus first and change at MARKTPLATZ to the O bus. Please get off the bus at the stop TECHNIK. The bus ride takes about 20 minutes and costs € 3.20.

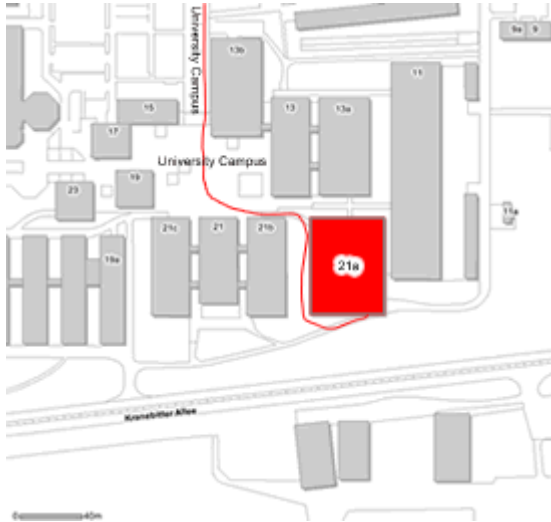
## Public Transportation

The two major buslines are the "O" and "T" bus.

### Bus nodes for the "O" bus:

Sillpark  
Landesmuseum  
Museumstraße  
Maria-Theresia-Straße (City Center)  
Marktplatz  
Klinik  
TECHNIK (where you have to get of the bus)

You can buy bus tickets at the driver and usually he/she will have change, but it is advisable to have small EURO bills and coins.



**On-campus directions**

The campus Technikerstraße is mainly a pedestrian area. Upon entering the campus from the North, walk south towards four-story building with a small statue on top. Turn left in front of this building. Continue going straight ahead towards a large sign 'IQI' and the entrance of the TransIT building. Our office is at the first floor.
