









PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

We recommend that you purchase a week ticket (Wocheskarte) for €17.10 or a 24-hour pass for €8. There are ticket machines in all the stations, including the airport. You can also purchase a ticket for a single ride from bus drivers or a machine on a tram.

MODUL UNIVERSITY

Unless you're driving, the only way to reach the university is by taking the 38A bus to the Kahlenberg stop. It is important to pay attention to the direction of the bus, as not all of them will go all the way to Kahlenberg.

Depending on where you will be staying, you can take different routes to reach the 38A bus. The simplest way is to take the U4 metro, direction Heiligenstadt, to the end of the line (Heiligenstadt Station).

The best way to orientate yourself with public transportation is to download the Quando app onto your phone.
